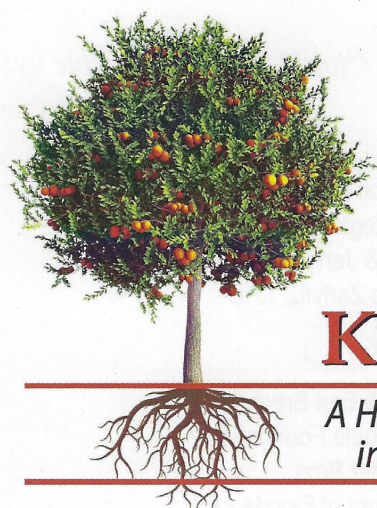

# Rabbi's Message

When prospective members and guests called recently to inquire about our High Holiday schedule, Congregation Beth Sholom President Linda Kost would often offer to tell them a bit about us, saying, "There are two things we consider important: first, we would like our congregation to be your spiritual family, and second, we would like the *shul* to be your spiritual home."

Our congregation's remarkable success in achieving those two goals was demonstrated during our Rosh Hashanah services. We were discussing the informality and interactiveness of our worship format, and a long-time member exclaimed, "We are a family!"

With her simple expression, I realized that we had, perhaps without consciously intending it, evolved beyond our motto, "The synagogue that feels like family," to actually *being* a family!

I did not yet imagine or dream that this diverse group of people would be so connected in spirit and in friendship that we would become truly a family by choice – but this is exactly what has happened here!

I am humbled and grateful to be the rabbi of this congregation, whose members care so deeply about each other and about our community. This is a moment for well-earned pride, but our leadership does not trumpet its successes, instead celebrating them quietly.
