Thank you to all of our members and guests who bring donations for the Leesburg Food Bank when you come to the synagogue.


They accept non perishable food, clothing, and small household items.

In an effort to help this population, and with many additional donations of service (such as our Hebrew school teacher Kelly Ann, who assisted in embroidering the bags) Katie raised enough money to stuff each canvas tote with 5 onesies, 3 bibs, 144 diapers, 3 packages of baby wipes, 4 pacifiers, 2 pacifier clips, one soft blanket, one digital thermometer and 2 washcloths. A total of 12 bags ended up being donated earlier this month, and as of the last call, all bags have now been given out to those in need!
