As I sit down to write this letter, we have just celebrated Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. It was wonderful to share this experience with so many members and guests. Rabbi Allen's chanting of Kol Nidre was certainly a highlight of our services.

For the members who were not able to attend the Kol Nidre service, I would like to share portions of my speech that you might find interesting.

As you realize we are a small synagogue and rely upon our wonderful members to keep this organization running as smoothly as possible. Some of the varied responsibilities of Our Board of Directors include:

Vice President Linda Kost had been President of Congregation Beth Sholom for more than 7 years and was hoping to cut back on her responsibilities. In any case, she is an invaluable member of the board handling the publication of the Shofar, maintaining our website, and sending out communications to the congregation.

Treasurer Dave Englander handles all our financial needs as well as coordinating the maintenance of the building and grounds. In addition, he is usually involved in any special projects that arise from time to time.

Diane Weinbaum has been Secretary for the past 3 years and chairs our Honey from the Heart fundraiser.

Board Director Fred Jacobs just recently accepted the position of Secretary which is much appreciated. Some of the various projects he has been involved with include helping members create permanent memorials of their loved ones on our Yahrzeit Board, securing our venue for the next seder; and coordinating the CPR/AED training class for CBS members. In addition, he and Helen donated new taleisim.

Board Director Bob Marcus has worked on various projects, assisting in the installation of the Ark and the repair of our outdoor sign, as well as providing business advice.

Board Director Barry Wright is our liaison to the Leesburg Food Bank. Barry brings all our donations to the Food Bank where they are distributed free of charge to the needy of the area. During 2019 we have delivered 569 pounds of food as well as a cash donation of \$813. Barry has also been instrumental in working with the Leesburg Police and Fire Departments to ensure that we do everything that is feasible to protect our members and our sanctuary. He arranges for the police presence at all our services.

Former Vice President Burt Kraft has been chairing our Passover seders for the last 5 years. In addition, he co-chairs the Mah Jongg Card Fundraiser with me. I would like to thank everyone who has ordered cards from us. If you play with a group, please ask them to order from us too!

We're fortunate to have members who generously donate their time and talents to make the shul a better and safer place.

Thank you to everyone that I have mentioned, and everyone else who has helped in some way. It's impossible to mention all of you.

Financial support happens not only when we need to make a special purchase, but throughout the year. The dues we collect do not fully cover our expenses. We depend on donations to cover more than 20% of our budget. Thank you to everyone who donated. Without those donations we simply would not exist. Thank you to all members and guests for your financial assistance.

Whether you are a member or a High Holiday guest, I hope to see you at a one of our upcoming events or services.
